RE: WINDOWS INCENTIVE CHANGES COMING OCTOBER 1, 2016

EFFECTIVE DATE: OCTOBER 1, 2016

The PUD is restructuring the Windows incentives offered through our Single Family Weatherization program effective October 1, 2016. These changes are necessary in order to maintain program cost-effectiveness in light of revised BPA kilowatt hour savings that take effect on this date.

Effective October 1, 2016, ONLY single-pane to double-pane (SP to DP) upgrades will be eligible for PUD Single Family Weatherization incentives. There will no longer be an incentive for double-pane to double-pane (DP to DP) upgrades.

The incentive amount for SP to DP upgrades will be unchanged, at \$6 per square foot. Any frame type (metal, vinyl, wood, etc.) will qualify so long as the upgrade is from single- to double-pane. The Multi-Family Weatherization program has not been affected by this change.

Knowing that PUD program incentive levels have an impact on your business, we are communicating this to you now, 3 months in advance, to provide as much opportunity as possible for you to optimize current incentive rates and plan for the transition. You may want to use this time to follow up with prospects who were undecided or who have been delaying a planned windows project. The PUD will promote efficient windows over the summer months to support your efforts, and will be providing notice of the coming change on the public website beginning today.

Application Deadlines

Any application received (or post-marked) by September 30 will be eligible for the current DP to DP incentive. On or after October 1st, 2016, only applications for SP to DP installations will be accepted.
