Eligibility

Must be an existing PUD residential customer. Vehicle must be a new or pre-owned, plug-in, four-wheel light-duty passenger battery electric vehicle (BEV) or plug-in electric/hybrid vehicle (PHEV) purchased or leased from a dealer-ship and registered at an active residential PUD account.
