Overview

Snohomish County PUD values the safety of our community and customers, and that includes those working and doing business around the electrical infrastructure. Please:

- Contact a PUD Designer at (425) 783-8272 before starting your project to review any requirements.
- **DO NOT** pull/remove a meter. Please leave that to a qualified PUD employee.
- **DO NOT** disconnect or transfer wires.

Discussion Points

- Per WAC 296-45-325, the removal, installation or modification of electrical meters, overhead electrical service conductors, and equipment is only to be performed by a qualified employee of Snohomish County PUD.
- Tampering with, modification or removal by other individuals will result in a referral to the Washington State Department of Labor and Industries and a minimum \$500 penalty being assessed against the Account Holder's monthly bill.
