Oil Spill Response and Remediation Summary 2022

In 2022, the PUD responded to 91 spill incidents involving a total of 805 gallons of transformer oil, 28 gallons of hydraulic oil, and 1 gallon of radiator fluid. A total of approximately 146 cubic yards of petroleum contaminated soils were removed, transported and disposed of at permitted disposal facilities. A summary of the spill types is listed below.
